An Ordinance to Appropriate Funds from the Federal Revenue Sharing Trust Fund


WHEREAS, IT HAS BEEN DETERMINED THAT IT IS NOW NECESSARY TO APPROPRIATE MORE MONEY THAN WAS APPROPRIATED IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET: NOW, THEREFORE,

SECTION I. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON OF MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA THAT FOR THE EXPENSES OF SAID MUNICIPAL CORPORATION THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL SUMS OF MONEY ARE HEREBY APPROPRIATED AND ORDERED SET APART OUT OF THE SEVERAL FUNDS HEREIN NAMED AND FOR THE PURPOSES HEREIN SPECIFIED, SUBJECT TO THE LAWS GOVERNING THE SAME:


SECTION II. THIS ORDINANCE shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.



SYNOPSIS

Appropriation Ordinance 77-3

An Ordinance to Appropriate Funds from the Federal Revenue Sharing Trust Fund

Under state law no money can be spent by the City without authorization from the Council in the form of an appropriation ordinance.

Weather conditions in January forced the Fire and Police Departments to realize the need the departments have for a four-wheel drive vehicle. Chief Gose worried that ambulance calls would be made which his department could not answer.

Through special emergency provisions, a vehicle was purchased. This appropriation authorizes payment.
