

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 77-9

AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING FROM THE LOCAL ROAD AND STREET FUND, CUMULATIVE CAPITAL FUND, FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING FUND, AND PUBLIC WORKS EMPLOYMENT TITLE II FUND EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget; now, therefore:

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON OF MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA THAT FOR THE EXPENSES OF SAID MUNICIPAL CORPORATION THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL SUMS OF MONEY ARE HEREBY APPROPRIATED AND ORDERED SET APART OUT OF THE SEVERAL FUNDS HEREIN NAMED AND FOR THE PURPOSES HEREIN SPECIFIED, SUBJECT TO THE LAWS GOVERNING THE SAME:



SYNOPSIS

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 77-9

An Ordinance to appropriate Funds from the Local Road and Street Fund, the Cumulative Capital Fund, the Federal Revenue Sharing Trust Fund, and the Local Public Works Employment Fund.

This ordinance appropriates funds for most of the first-year projects as set out in the City of Bloomington's five-year capital improvements plan and two unanticipated expenditures.

Unanticipated expenditures are the demolition of the Old Library, suggested unanimously by the Board of Public Works, and emergency street repairs made necessary by the unusually bad winter and to be funded both from Federal Revenue Sharing and Public Works Employment-Title II.

Previously planned projects to be funded are: a match for the federal grant to perform an environmental study of Third Street improvements, Phase I of Smith Road improvements, two traffic signals, a sidewalk on South Henderson running from BHS South to <sup>WINSLOW RD.</sup> Henderson, a sidewalk on 10th running from Fountain Park to the By-pass, roof improvements in the Sanitation Garage, roof and floor improvements at the Older American Center, Crestmont Park Drainage Improvements, and Ninth-Street Park Improvements. These projects are set out in detail in the Capital Improvement budget.

Finally, \$15,000.00 is appropriated to Parks and Recreation from Revenue Sharing to replace that money spent on hockey equipment.
