

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 77- 15

AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING FROM THE CUMULATIVE CAPITAL FUND AND THE FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING TRUST FUND EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget; now, therefore:

SECTION I. Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington of Monroe County, Indiana that for the expenses of said municipal corporation the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the several funds herein named and for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same:



SYNOPSIS

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Under state law, no money can be spent by the City without authorization from the Council in the form of an appropriation ordinance.

The Parks & Recreation Department has received \$75,000.00 from the State Bureau of Outdoor Recreation, Department of Natural Resources, as a kind of credit received for the 1974 Park Bond program. The money is to be used as part of the local match for the Winslow Sports Complex. For that reason, it has been receipted into Cumulative Capital Fund so that it may be appropriated to join the rest of the local match, \$50,000 in Cumulative Capital #26.

The Animal Control Commission and the Shelter Director are concerned about the poor, perhaps dangerous, condition of the animal disposal incinerator. This appropriation from Revenue Sharing will enable the Shelter to purchase a new incinerator. Because the company receiving the bid will also install the incinerator and educate the Shelter employees about its operation and maintenance, the money is appropriated to Contractual Services.
