APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 77-19

AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING FROM THE FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING TRUST FUND AND THE GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget; now, therefore,

SECTION I. Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington of Monroe County, Indiana that for the expenses of said municipal corporation the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the several funds herein named and for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same:

SYNOPSIS

Appropriation Ordinance 77-19

Under State law, no money can be spent by the City without authorization from the Council in the form of an appropriation ordinance. This ordinance addresses two separate matters.

The Mayor has agreed to an appropriation for the Youth Shelter of \$2,000 beyond the \$2,189 already voted by the Council.

The City's former grantsperson, Eve Brigl, gave several grants seminars on behalf of the City this year. Fees were charged to cover expenses of room rental and purchase of necessary publications. Those fees were receipted, according to legal procedure, into the General Fund.

In the meantime, Human Resources paid \$261.40 for room rentals, and the Controller's Office paid \$352.92 for publications. Both departments now hope to appropriate a portion of the general fund receipts to their departments in order to negate the extra expenses of the grantsworkshops.
