

ORDINANCE 76-3

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BLOOMINGTON
ZONING MAPS, DATED JUNE 22, 1973

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 21, 1973, and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Ordinance and maps are now incorporated in the "Bloomington Municipal Code" as Title 20 of said Code, and

WHEREAS, Section 20.09.03.00 permits the Common Council to officially designate buildings, structures, or districts as "historic", and

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission, upon advice of the Historic District and Buildings Study Committee, has recommended the designation of certain structures, buildings, or sites as "historic",


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, that under the authority of Chapter 174 of the 1947 Acts of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana as amended that the following described property be designated as an historic site:

SECTION 1. That incorporated map number 7 of June 22, 1973, be amended to designate the property commonly known as Seminary Park an historic site within the City of Bloomington, Indiana, described as follows, to-wit:

A part of Seminary Square located in the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, as recorded in Deed Record A, page 55 in the Office of the Recorder of Monroe County, Indiana, bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the Northeast corner of Seminary Square running thence South 185 feet; running thence West 228.75 feet; running thence North 185 feet; running thence East 288.75 feet and to the place of beginning.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.


