

ORDINANCE NO. 76-8

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF  
ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,  
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the  
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of  
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the Southeast quarter of Section 10,  
Township 8 North, Range 1 West in Monroe County,  
Indiana, more particularly described as follows:  
Beginning on the East line of the said quarter  
section, South 00 degrees 06 minutes 30 seconds  
West, 1343.00 feet from the Northeast corner of  
the said quarter section (the said place of be-  
ginning is the southeast corner of Lot 10 in  
"Spicewood, Addition-Section One", the plat of  
which was recorded April 2, 1973, in Plat Book  
6, page 30, in the Office of the Recorder of  
Monroe County, Indiana); thence South 00 degrees  
06 minutes 30 seconds West along the said East  
line 185.00 feet; thence North 89 degrees 53  
minutes 30 seconds West, 190.00 feet; thence  
North 00 degrees 06 minutes 30 seconds East  
5.81 feet; thence North 89 degrees 53 minutes  
30 seconds West 131.61 feet; thence South 00  
degrees 48 minutes 44 seconds West, 28.39 feet;  
thence North 89 degrees 11 minutes 16 seconds  
West 180.00 feet; thence North 00 degrees 48  
minutes 44 seconds East 30.00 feet; thence  
North 89 degrees 11 minutes 16 seconds West,  
590.00 feet to the Southeast corner of Lot 55  
in "Spicewood Addition-Section Two", the plat of  
which was recorded March 12, 1973, in Plat Book  
6, page 70, in the Office of the Recorder of  
Monroe County, Indiana (the next four (4) courses  
are along the Easterly and Southerly bounds of  
the said "Spicewood Addition-Section Two") thence  
North 00 degrees 48 minutes 44 seconds East  
105.00 feet; thence South 89 degrees 11 minutes  
16 seconds East 95.00 feet; thence South 00  
degrees 48 minutes 44 seconds East 105.00 feet;  
thence South 89 degrees 11 minutes 16 seconds  
East 95.00 feet; thence South 00 degrees 48  
minutes 44 seconds West 5.00 feet; thence South  
89 degrees 11 minutes 16 seconds East 305.00 feet  
to the Southwest corner of the said "Spicewood  
Addition-Section One" (the next three (3) courses  
are along the Southerly and Easterly bounds of  
the said "Spicewood Addition-Section One");  
thence South 89 degrees 11 minutes 16 seconds  
East 560.37 feet; thence North 00 degrees 06  
minutes 30 seconds East 79.93 feet; thence South  
89 degrees 53 minutes 30 seconds East 130.00 feet  
to the place of beginning, containing 2.903 acres,  
more or less.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.
