

ORDINANCE 76-36

AN ORDINANCE SPECIFYING CONDEMNATION POWERS IN
THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS.


BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA THAT:

SECTION 1. Section 2.08.010 of the Bloomington Municipal Code shall be amended to add the following before the last sentence of that section:

The powers of the Board shall be those specifically set out by state law, and shall specifically include, but in no way be limited to, the power of condemnation as described in I.C. 18-1-6-15.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and promulgation by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.

PASSED and ADOPTED by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana upon the 17 day of June, 1976.



Synopsis
Ordinance 76-36

An Ordinance specifying condemnation powers in the Board of Public Works.

Bloomington had a Board of Public Works and Safety before 1966 to deal with the areas of public works, such as water and roads, and public safety, such as fire and police departments. In 1966, the two areas were split and two separate boards were created: the Board of Public Works and the Board of Public Safety. When the split was made, the power to condemn was vested in the Board of Public Safety. The city has found, however, that it would be more advantageous to vest it instead in the Board of Public Works, since it is more directly concerned with the management of property in the City.

This Ordinance specifies that the power of condemnation will now vest in the Board of Public Works.


