

ORDINANCE 76-37

TO AMEND SECTION 14.36.090 OF THE BLOOMINGTON MUNICIPAL CODE, TITLED "INTOXICATING BEVERAGES - CONSUMPTION IN PUBLIC"

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 14.36.090 of the Bloomington Municipal Code be amended to add:

provided, however, that it shall not be unlawful to consume beer or wine, regardless of where it was purchased, at an event for which the Indiana Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission has issued a temporary beer permit as authorized by I.C. 7.1-3-6-1 et seq. or a temporary wine permit as authorized by I.C. 7.1-3-16-5 et seq. to a qualified person to sell beer or wine or both at that event.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and promulgation by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.

SYNOPSIS

ORDINANCE 76-37

TO AMEND SECTION 14.36.090 OF THE BLOOMINGTON MUNICIPAL
CODE, TITLED "INTOXICATING BEVERAGES - CONSUMPTION IN PUBLIC"

Section 14.36.090 of the Bloomington Municipal Code makes it illegal for anyone in the City to consume intoxicating beverages on any publicly owned place or highway, "whether within, on or outside of a motor vehicle of any type".

State law allows the Indiana Alcoholic Beverage Commission to issue temporary beer and wine permits to allow the sale of those beverages at public events after certain criteria have been met by the people applying for those permits.

This ordinance would allow public consumption of beer and wine at those events for which temporary beer and wine permits have been issued by the State Commission.


