ORDINANCE 76-73

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BLOOMINGTON ZONING MAPS, DATED JUNE 22, 1973

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 21, 1973, and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Ordinance and maps are now incorporated in the Bloomington Municipal Code as Title 20 of said Code, and

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission has considered this case Z0-38-76 and recommended said Bloomington zoning maps be amended by the rezoning of certain property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, that under the authority of Chapter 174 of the 1947 Acts of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana as amended that the property commonly known as a tract of land located at 1435 Jackson be rezoned from Residential Low Density to Residential High Density.

SECTION 1. That the incorporated map number 3, of June 22, 1973, be amended to rezone the following described land as follows, to-wit:

SYNOPSIS ORDINANCE 76-73 (PLAN COMMISSION CASE NO. ZO-38-76) SEPTEMBER 29, 1976

The Zoning Ordinance classifies all land within the planning jurisdiction into residential, business, and manufacturing zones. The boundaries for these zones are established by the Plan Commission and Common Council and within each district only certain uses are permitted.

This ordinance will change the zoning for a tract of land commonly known as 1435 Jackson from RL Residential Low Density to RH Residential High Density.

The purpose of this rezoning is to permit the construction of apartments for the elderly.
