ORDINANCE NO. 76-81

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 15 OF THE BLOOMINGTON MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTIONS 15.36.200, ENTITLED, "ONE WAY STREETS AND ALLEYS; 15.64.080, ENTITLED, "PARALLELED PARKING (UNLIMITED); 15.64.370, ENTITLED, "RESTRICTED PARKING ZONES; AND 15.64.410, ENTITLED, "NO PARKING ZONES".

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That Section 15.36.200, entitled, "One Way Streets and Alleys, be amended by adding thereto the following:

Eastside Drive from Third Street to Atwater one way Street South.

SECTION 2. That Section 15.64.080, entitled, "Paralleled Parking (Unlimited), be amended by adding thereto the following:

Eastside Drive between Third Street and Atwater on the west side of the street.

Sixth Street between Madison and Rogers Street on both sides of the street with the exception of the first two (2) parking spaces on the south side of Sixth Street East of Rogers.

SECTION 3. That Section 15.64.370, entitled, "Restricted Parking Zones", be amended by adding thereto the following:

First two (2) spaces on the South side of Sixth Street east of Rogers, two (2) hour time zone.

SECTION 4. That Section 15.64.410, entitled, "No Parking Zones", be amended by adding thereto the following:

East side of Pine Street between Sixth Street and Seventh Streets.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and signature in accordance with the law.

SYNOPSIS

ORDINANCE NO. 76- 8/

An Ordinance to Amend the Bloomington Municipal
Code Regarding One Way Streets & Alleys, Paralleled
Parking (Unlimited), Restricted Parking Zones and
No Parking Zones.

The City of Bloomington has the power to make laws regarding certain aspects of parking and traffic control on its streets, and these are collected in the "Vehicles and Traffic" sections of the Bloomington Municipal Code. Consequently, when parking, speed zone, or sign changes are found to be required by the Traffic Commission or other member of the City Administration, the Council must amend the code to incorporate the changes.

This ordinance makes changes in the One Way Streets and Alleys, Paralleled Parking (Unlimited), Restricted Parking Zones and No Parking Zones of the code as follows:

Paralleled Parking (Unlimited) - Eastside Drive between Third Street and Atwater on the West side of Street.

Sixth Street between Madison and Rogers Street on both sides of the street with exception of the first two parking spaces on the south side of Sixth Street East of Rogers.

One Way Streets and Alleys

- Eastside Drive from Third Street to Atwater one way street South.

Restricted Parking Zones

 First two spaces on the south side of Sixth Street east of Rogers, two hour time zone.

No Parking Zones

- East side of Pine Street between Sixth and Seventh Streets.
