SYNOPSIS

Resolution 76-20

Budget Transfer for Animal Control

When money is budgeted for use by the city departments, it is broken into "line items", such as services personal, equipment, etc. State law requires that money from one line item cannot be used for something covered by another line item without a budget transfer by resolution by the Common Council.

This resolution transfers money within the Animal Control budget. The Repairs to Equipment line item of the budget has only \$1.59 left out of \$600 because of very heavy, unanticipated expenses in the repair on the Animal Control vehicles and the incinerator, and so is having \$300 transferred into it. The transferred money is coming from the Traveling Expenses line item, which contains more money than will be needed because animal control vehicles no longer service county areas.
