

SYNOPSIS

RESOLUTION 76-_____

A RESOLUTION ADJUSTING APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN THE ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT

When money is budgeted for use by the City departments, it is broken into "line items," such as services personal, equipment, etc. State law requires that money from one item cannot be used for something covered by another line item without a budget transfer by action of the Common Council. This transfer may be accomplished by resolution rather than ordinance because it transfers appropriations only within major categories and not between major categories.

The Engineering Department is requesting larger appropriations in several categories: in 722 to make possible an unanticipated purchase, in 37 to update departmental forms, and in 214 to cover telephone expenses.

\$350 from Account #722 to #725

The Engineering Department is obtaining a 1953 model, three wheel Harley Davidson motorcycle from the Police Department. Since the Police Department had intended to auction this vehicle off in August, 1976 some monetary compensation from the Engineering Department to the Police Department is in order, thus this request for transfer of funds.

The Engineering Department will use this vehicle for parts to maintain the 1959 model cycle that is used by the Street Inspector. Virtually all parts are interchangeable between the two vehicles.

\$250 from Account #32 to #37

This department is also thinking of updating the forms used by this office. The ones now being used are obsolete and need to be reformed, thus the need for this transfer. Purchase of code books is also anticipated.

\$150 from Account #213 to #214

This office also deals with a lot of consulting firms and construction companies outside the Bloomington area, which we deal with almost on a daily basis. Increasing this account is indeed a necessity.
