SYNOPSIS

RESOLUTION 76-

A RESOLUTION ADJUSTING APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN THE ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT

When money is budgeted for use by the City departments, it is broken into "line items," such as services personal, equipment, etc. State law requires that money from one item cannot be used for something covered by another line item without a budget transfer by action of the Common Council. This transfer may be accomplished by resolution rather than ordinance because it transfers appropriations only within major categories and not between major caregories.

The Engineering Department is requesting larger appropriations in several categories: in 722 to make possible an unanticipated purchase, in 37 to update departmental forms, and in 214 to cover telephone expenses.
