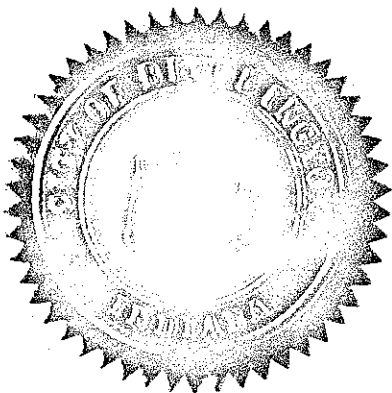
SECTION I. The Common Council congratulates Wilbert Miller for his long years of service to the City of Bloomington and its people and wishes him the best of luck in the years ahead.
