AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING FROM THE GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, TO MEET THE EXTRA-ORDINARY EMERGENCY FOUND TO EXIST

WHEREAS, certain extraordinary emergencies have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, to meet such extraordinary emergencies, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION I. That there be, and hereby is appropriated from the General Fund of said City, funds not otherwise appropriated to meet the extraordinary emergencies found to exist for the expenditure of more money for the current year of 1976 than was set out in detail in the budget as finally adopted and appropriations as finally made, the following sum:

26 Other Contractual Services \$15,000.00

SECTION II. THIS ORDINANCE shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.

SYNOPSIS OF RATIONALE FOR ORDINANCE 76-___

The appropriation of \$15,000 from the General Fund to line 26 of the Board of Works budget is necessary to the funding of the Space Needs Study to be contracted for jointly by the City of Bloomington and the County of Monroe.

The \$15,000 comes originally from State Revenue Sharing and was appropriated for the Space Needs Study last year. At the year's close, it reverted to the General Fund because a contract had not been let. It must, then, be reappropriated.
