

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 76-9

AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING FROM THE FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING TRUST FUND EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, TO MEET THE EXTRAORDINARY EMERGENCY FOUND TO EXIST.

WHEREAS, certain extraordinary emergencies have developed since adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, to meet such extraordinary emergencies, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:


SECTION I. That there be, and hereby is appropriated from the Federal Revenue Sharing Trust Fund of said City, funds not otherwise appropriated to meet the extraordinary emergencies found to exist for the expenditure of more money for the current year of 1976 than was set out in detail in the budget as finally adopted and appropriations as finally made, the following sum:

SYNOPSIS

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 76-9

To Appropriate Funds from Federal Revenue Sharing Trust Fund to the  
Department of Human Resources and Parks and Recreation Department

This ordinance requestes \$3,885.90 in revenue sharing funds for the Human Resources Department to produce an Information and Referral Resource Book. Human Resources, working in conjunction with the Community Service Council and numerous other area social service agencies, is involved in developing an information and referral system that would accurately identify the many social services that are available in this community. An essential part of this system is an Information and Referral Resource Book which will provide indepth information on over 200 community agencies and cross-index this information in a variety of ways.

An additional \$7,000 is requested for the Parks and Recreation Department to join in a cooperative venture with the Monroe County Community School Corporation to light 8 tennis courts at Bloomington High School North and 6 tennis courts at Bloomington High School South. The School Corporation is providing all materials; the City will provide for installation. Lighting of these 14 fourts will greatly increase the number of community facilities available for evening tennis.


