

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 76-16

TO SPECIFICALLY APPROPRIATE FROM THE FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING TRUST FUND EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA.

WHEREAS it has been determined that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget,


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA THAT:

SECTION I. For the expenses of said municipal corporation the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the several funds herein named and for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same.

SECTION II. The Common Council in amending these federal revenue sharing funds expects and anticipates forty-eight percent of these funds (\$2,592), to be returned to the City of Bloomington by the end of calendar year 1978.


APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 76-16

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING TRUST FUND TO THE WORK RELEASE CENTER

Under state law, no money can be spent by the city without authorization from the Council in the form of an appropriation ordinance. Since the monies covered by this ordinance were not part of the budget for 1976 passed last August, they must now be approved by the Council if they are to be spent.

Criminal Justice funds for the Work Release Center will expire at the end of July and are not scheduled to resume until the beginning of October. The Work Release Center has developed a revised "bare-bones" budget of \$8,200 for the months of August and September. They have received \$1,000 from a private donor; they anticipate receiving \$1,800 in per diems. This leaves a deficit of \$5,400, the amount requested from Federal Revenue Sharing.
