ORDINANCE NO. 75-14

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

> Lot Number 3 in Maple Grove Baby Farms Subdivision, being a part of the Southwest quarter of Section 31, and a part of the Northwest quarter of Section 31, and part of the Southeast quarter of Section 31, and part of the Northeast quarter of Section 31, all in Township 9 North, Range 1 West, excepting there-from the following: 535 feet off the entire North side of Lot Number 8 in Maple Grove Baby Farms Subdivision, being a part of the Southwest quarter of Section 31, and a part of the Northwest quarter of Section 31, and part of the Southeast quarter of Section 31 and part of the Northeast quarter of Section 31 all in Township 9 North, Range 1 West, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point 265 feet North of the Southeast corner of said Lot, said Southeast corner being located at the North right-of-way line of Old State Road #48, running thence North 535 feet; thence West 132 feet; thence South 535 feet; thence East 132 feet to the place of beginning, containing 1.62 acres, more or less.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.
