

ORDINANCE NO. 75-33

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF
ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the Southeast quarter of Section ten
(10), Township Eight (8) North, Range One (1)
West in Monroe County, Indiana, described as
follows:

All of "Spicewood-Second Addition" as platted
and recorded in Plat Book 6, page 70 in the
Office of the Monroe County Recorder, Bloomington,
Indiana.

Also, all of "Spicewood-Third Addition" as platted
and recorded in Plat Book 6, page 71 in the Office
of the Monroe County Recorder, Bloomington, Indiana.

Also, part of the Southeast Quarter of Section Ten
(10), Township Eight (8) North, Range One (1) West
in Monroe County, Indiana, more particularly de-
scribed as follows:

Beginning on the West line of the said Quarter
Section a distance of One Thousand Six Hundred
Fourteen and Eighty Hundredths (1614.80) feet
South Zero (00) degrees Fourteen (14) minutes
Forty-Eight (48) seconds East from the Northwest
corner of the said Quarter Section; thence North
Eighty-Nine (89) degrees Forty-Five (45) minutes
Twelve (12) Seconds East Three Hundred (300.00)
feet; thence North Fifty-Seven (57) degrees
Forty-Five (45) minutes Twelve (12) Seconds
East Three Hundred Forty-Five (345.00) feet;
thence North Thirty-One (31) degrees Fifteen (15)
minutes Twelve (12) Seconds East Two Hundred
Fifty-Five (255.00) feet; thence North Sixty (60)
degrees Fifteen (15) minutes Twelve (12) seconds
East Two Hundred Eighty-Eight and Ninety Hundredths
(288.90) feet; thence South Fourteen (14) degrees
Forty-Three (43) minutes Forty-One (41) seconds
East Nine Hundred Fifty-Four and Twenty-One
Hundredths (954.21) feet to a point witnessed
by a six (6) inch square cut stone bearing North
Eighty-Nine (89) degrees Eleven (11) minutes
Sixteen (16) seconds West One Thousand One Hundred
Ninety-Six and Eight Hundredths (1196.08) feet
and a six (6) inch square cut stone bearing South
Eighty-Nine (89) degrees Eleven (11) minutes
Sixteen (16) seconds East One Thousand Four Hundred
Four and Forty-Eight Hundredths (1404.48) feet;
thence North Eighty-Nine (89) degrees Eleven (11)
minutes Sixteen (16) seconds West One Thousand Two
Hundred Sixteen and Eight Hundredths (1216.08)

feet to the West line of the said Quarter Section; thence North Zero (00) degrees Fourteen (14) minutes Forty-eight (48) seconds West along the said West line Three Hundred Fifty-Eight and Ninety-Two Hundredths (358.92) feet to the place of beginning, containing Fifteen (15.000), acres, more or less.

Also, part of the Southeast Quarter of Section Ten (10), Township Eight (8) North, Range One (1) West in Monroe County, Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning on the West line of the said Quarter Section a distance of One Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Four and Eighty Hundredths (1534.80) feet South Zero (00) Degrees Fourteen (14) minutes Forty-Eight (48) seconds East from the Northwest Corner of the said Quarter Section; thence South Zero (00) degrees Fourteen (14) minutes Forty-Eight (48) seconds East along the West line of the said Quarter Section Eighty (80.00) feet; thence North Eighty-Nine (89) degrees Forty-Five (45) minutes Twelve (12) seconds East Three Hundred (300.00) feet; thence North Fifty-Seven (57) degrees Forty-Five (45) minutes Twelve (12) seconds East One Hundred Fifty and Ninety-Seven Hundredths (150.97) feet; thence South Eighty-Nine (89) degrees Forty-Five (45) minutes Twelve (12) seconds West Four Hundred Twenty-Eight and Three Hundredths (428.03) feet to the place of beginning, containing Six Hundred Sixty-Nine Thousandths (0.669) acres, more or less.

Also, a part of the South half of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter, of Section Ten (10), Township Eight (8) North, Range One (1) West, in Monroe County, Indiana, bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point which is Five Hundred Seventy-Two and Five Tenths (572.5) feet North of the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of said Section, said point being in the center of South High Street, thence running North Two (2) degrees Seventeen (17) minutes West, over and along the center line of South High Street, for a distance of Ninety-Eight (98) feet; thence running North Eighty-Nine (89) degrees Fifty-Three (53) minutes Fifty (50) seconds East for a distance of One Hundred Seventy-Five (175) feet; thence running South Two (2) degrees Seventeen (17) minutes East for a distance of Sixty-Five (65) feet; thence running South Eighty-Nine (89) degrees Fifty-Three (53) minutes Fifty (50) seconds West for a distance of Sixty (60) feet; thence running South Two (2) degrees Seventeen (17) minutes East for a distance of Thirty-Three (33) feet; thence running South Eighty-Nine (89) degrees Fifty-Three (53) minutes Fifty (50) seconds West for a distance of One Hundred Fifteen (115) feet, and to the place of beginning, containing 0.348 acre, more or less.


The above described real estate consists of Spicewood, Second and Third Additions, the site of Childs School, and property owned by Sandra Kay Moore.
