

ORDINANCE 75-43

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 14 OF THE BLOOMINGTON
MUNICIPAL CODE, SECTION 14.09.070, ENTITLED
"SPECIAL PERMITS"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON,
INDIANA, COUNTY OF MONROE:

SECTION 1: That Section 14.09.070 of the Bloomington Municipal
Code, entitled "Special Permits," be amended by adding thereto:

- d. The Mayor may authorize Civic Event Permits. These
permits shall be limited to the hours of seven (7)
a.m. and twelve (12) midnight, shall be issued for
not longer than one day, and shall not be renewable.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect
from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in
accordance with the law.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FROM THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUND.

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington, Indiana is entitled to the sum of \$1,004,000.00 as a Non-Metropolitan Entitlement City (Sec. 106) under the provisions of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-383); and,

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington, Indiana has completed grant application B-75-HN-18-0002 in April 11, 1975, and

WHEREAS, Grant No. B-75-HN-18-0002 was approved for funding as submitted and proposed in May 20, 1975, and

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington, Indiana has reached a finding of not significant impact in the Environment, and, said finding has been published and no contradictory findings or comments have been received, and, therefore, said finding and said Publication have been affirmed completing the City of Bloomington's obligation under 24 CFR S 58.16, Environmental Regulations for Title I Programming

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:
