

ORDINANCE 75-69

AN ORDINANCE TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE BLOOMINGTON DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Indiana Acts 1975, Public Law 187 Section 3 changed the term city "Development Commission" to city "Economic Development Commission"; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council has determined that the term "Economic Development Commission" is a more appropriate title for the "Bloomington Development Commission"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA THAT:

SECTION I. The Bloomington Municipal Code Chapter 2.79 be amended so that each place the term "Bloomington Development Commission" appears it be changed to "Bloomington Economic Development Commission."

SECTION II. THIS ORDINANCE shall be in full force and effect after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and its approval by the Mayor.
