

RESOLUTION 75- 5

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington, Indiana is eligible for a Community Development Block Grant of \$1,004,000.00 for fiscal year 1975 pursuant to the 1974 Housing and Community Development Act and,

WHEREAS, the national objectives of the program are as follows:

- (1) The elimination of slums and blight and the prevention of blighting influences and the deterioration of property and neighborhood and community facilities of importance to the welfare of the community, principally to persons of low and moderate income;
- (2) the elimination of conditions which are detrimental to health, safety, and public welfare, through code enforcement, demolition, interim rehabilitation assistance, and related activities;
- (3) the conservation and expansion of the Nation's housing stock in order to provide a decent home and a suitable living environment for all persons, but principally those of low and moderate income;
- (4) the expansion and improvement of the quantity and quality of community services, principally for persons of low and moderate income, which are essential for sound community development and for the development of viable urban communities;

and

- (5) the reduction of the isolation of income groups within communities and geographical areas and the promotion of an increase in the diversity and vitality of neighborhoods through the spatial de-concentration of housing opportunities for persons of lower income and the revitalization of deteriorating or deteriorated neighborhoods to attract persons of higher income; and,

WHEREAS, THE FIRST YEAR SUMMARY BUDGET PREPARED FOR THE MAYOR BY THE WORKABLE PROGRAM COMMITTEE MEETS THE LOCAL AND NATIONAL OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAM AND THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1974.


