

From #111- Salaries to Travel #213 - \$500.00. We have been sending people to school when possible, we started with \$1500.00 and only have \$238.00 left.

From #111- Salaries to Repair Parts #43 - \$1500.00. We started this year with \$2000.00 and due to breakdowns of equipment, which we did not count on, our balance is zero.

We have extra money in #111- Salaries due to promotions and vacancies not being filled until late this year.

From #111 - Salaries to Medical Supplies #33 - \$1,000.00. The purchase of splints, inverter, and constant demand for all medical supplies is depleting our medical funds, so we find it necessary to reimburse this fund with extra monies.
