

RESOLUTION 75-25

WHEREAS, there has existed in Bloomington, Indiana since 1958 a group of approximately forty spelunkers who volunteer to be called by area police agencies for cave rescues, and

WHEREAS, that group makes up to twenty rescues per year, often saving lives, and

WHEREAS, on the night of August 7, 1975, Mike Moore, Don Paquette, Jim Keith, Dick Blenz, Bud Dillon, Dexter Luck and Dave Garrett, all of this rescue group, demonstrated the group's practiced expertise by quickly and professionally rescuing five people lost in Buckner Cave,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, that the Common Council congratulates the rescue group generally, and the seven members who took part in the most recent rescue in particular, for this valuable, hazardous and necessary service they voluntarily performed for the community.
