## RESOLUTION 75-34

WHEREAS it is the public policy of the City of Bloomington, Indiana to encourage joint and cooperative efforts in the provision of public services and,

WHEREAS the General Assembly of the State of Indiana through Public Law 305 of 1975 mandated the establishment of a County Court without corresponding increases in each County's reserves to support such court,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of Bloomington, Indiana is hereby empowered to offer to the Board of County Commissioners of Monroe County the two year lease of the City Court room and attendant offices, for the annual rental charge of thirteen hundred fifty dollars (\$1350.00).

Section 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
