


RESOLUTION 75-40

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana has become aware of allegations concerning irregularities in the conduct of the recent City elections; and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes that the County Election Board is empowered to investigate the conduct of City elections and to administer oaths, issue subpoenas and compel testimony in such an investigation under authority of Indiana Code (1945) 3-1-4-7 (Burns 29-3107);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, that the Council urges the Monroe County Election Board to use its statutory powers to determine whether or not irregularities did occur in the City elections held on November 4, 1975.
