APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE No. 75-2

AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING FROM REVENUE SHARING TRUST FUND EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA TO MEET THE EXTRAORDINARY EMERGENCY FOUND TO EXIST.

WHEREAS, certain extraordinary emergencies have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget:

NOW, THEREFORE, to meet such extraordinary emergency, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION I. That there be, and hereby is appropriated from Federal Revenue Sharing Trust Fund of said City, funds not otherwise appropriated, to meet the extraordinary emergency found to exist for the expenditure of more money for the current year of 1975 than was set out in detail in the budget as finally adopted and appropriations as finally made, the following sums:
