

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE No. 75-3

AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING FROM GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, TO MEET THE EXTRAORDINARY EMERGENCY FOUND TO EXIST.

WHEREAS, certain extraordinary emergencies have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, to meet such extraordinary emergencies, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

Section I. That there be, and hereby is appropriated from the General Fund of said City, funds not otherwise appropriated, to meet the extraordinary emergency found to exist for the expenditure of more money for the current year of 1975 than was set out in detail in the budget as finally adopted and appropriations as finally made, the following sum:

- To: BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS
- 7 PROPERTIES
- 72 Equipment. (Jaws of Life). . . . \$2,633.00

This "Jaws of Life" is a Hurst rescue tool, complete with chains, hooks, etc., which will be used by the Fire Department along with their ambulance service.

Section II. THIS ORDINANCE shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.
