APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE
No. 75-8

AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING MONIES TO MEET EXTRAORDINARY
EMERGENCIES FOUND TO EXIST

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget; NOW, THEREFORE:

SECTION I. BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, that for the expenses of said municipal corporation, the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the several funds herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same, to-wit:

From REVENUE SHARING TRUST FUND:

To POLICE DEPARTMENT - Revenue Sharing:

- 1 SERVICES PERSONAL
 - 11 Salaries and Wages, Regular \$ 2,500

To FIRE DEPARTMENT - Revenue Sharing:

- 7 PROPERTIES
 - 72 Equipment (2 Ambulances) \$40,000

Total (From Revenue Sharing Fund) . . \$42,500

From GENERAL FUND:


To BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS:

- 262 Contractual Services \$24,500
(Reimbursement by State for Traffic Engineering Safety Study)

Total (From General Fund) \$24,500
