## AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING MONIES TO MEET EXTRAORDINARY EMERGENCY FOUND TO EXIST

WHEREAS, certain extraordinary emergencies have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated for the year 1975; NOW, THEREFORE:

SECTION I. BE IT ORDAINED BN THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, that for the expenses of said municipal corporation, the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING TRUST FUND, subject to the law governing the same, to-wit:

## TO: FIRE DEPARTMENT - REVENUE SHARING FUND

7 Properties

722 Motor Equipment . . . . . . \$13,700

This appropriation is to be used by the Fire Department to replace the amount expended on the Emergency Ambulance. The necessity to purchase this ambulance was approved by Resolution 75-27 by the Common Council at their regular meeting on September 4, 1975.

SECTION II. THIS ORDINANCE shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
