

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE No. 75-12

AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING MONIES TO MEET EXTRAORDINARY EMERGENCIES FOUND TO EXIST

WHEREAS, an extraordinary emergency has developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated for the year 1975; NOW, THEREFORE:

SECTION I. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, that the said Council appropriate for the emergency expenditure of said municipal corporation, the following additional sum of money, and that the same be hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the General Fund, subject to the laws governing the same, to-wit:

SECTION II. THIS ORDINANCE shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
