

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE No. 75-13

AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING MONIES TO MEET EXTRAORDINARY EMERGENCY FOUND TO EXIST

WHEREAS, an emergency has developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated for the year 1975; NOW, THEREFORE:

SECTION I. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, that the said Council appropriates for the expenditure or said municipal corporation, the following additional sum of money which has been received from the County of Monroe for capital improvement in the County Park System, to-wit:
