

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 75-17

AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING MONIES TO MEET EXTRAORDINARY EMERGENCIES FOUND TO EXIST

WHEREAS, certain extraordinary emergencies have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated for the year 1975;

SECTION I. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA that for the expenses of said municipal corporation, the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the funds herein specified, subject to laws governing the same, to-wit:
