

ORDINANCE NO. 74-4

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION  
OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUCUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,  
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the  
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of  
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the Southeast quarter of Section 6,  
Township 8 North, Range 1 West, bounded and  
described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at  
a point on the West line of said Southeast  
quarter, 280 feet South of the Northwest  
corner of said southeast quarter, running  
thence South on the West line of said south-  
east quarter 305 feet, thence East 962 feet  
to the West line of the land owned by Clyde  
Jones, thence North  $121\frac{1}{2}$  feet, thence East  
97 feet, thence south 313 feet to the center  
of the Dinsmore Pike, thence North of East  
along the center of Dinsmore Pike 333 feet  
to the center of the New Pike, thence along  
the center of the New Pike 258 feet to the  
Southeast corner of the land this day deeded  
by the grantor to Clyde W. Carter, thence  
West along the south line of the land of said  
Carter 1330 feet to the place of beginning,  
containing  $8\frac{1}{2}$  acres, more or less, said land  
being part of Seminary Out Lots 189 and 190,  
EXCEPTING THEREFROM the following described  
real estate: Part of the southeast quarter  
of Section 6, Township 8 North, Range 1 West,  
bounded and described as follows, to-wit:  
Beginning at a point that is 1090.33 feet  
East and 413 feet South of the Northwest  
corner of the southeast quarter of Section 6,  
Township 8 North, Range 1 West, running thence  
East 60 feet, thence South 2 degrees East  
for a distance of 241 feet and to the North  
edge of the concrete pavement of Indiana State  
Road Number 45, thence South 52 degrees West  
along the said North edge of the pavement  
for a distance of 69.3 feet; thence running  
North 3 degrees West for a distance of 285  
feet to the place of beginning, containing  
in all .39 acres in said exception, more or  
less.

Said above described real estate is the  
location of Bloomington Lodge No. 1081, Loyal  
Order of the Moose.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.
