

ORDINANCE NO. 74-5

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION
OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:


A part of Section 28, Township 9 North,
Range 1 West in Monroe County, Indiana,
more particularly described as follows,
to-wit: Lot Number 7 in Miller Courts
Addition to the City of Bloomington,
Indiana; Also forty (40) feet by parallel
lines off of the North side of Lot Number
6 in Miller Courts Addition to the City
of Bloomington, Indiana.

Said above described real estate is the
location of Pancho's Villa Restaurant.


SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries

and publication in accordance with the law.


