

ORDINANCE NO. 74-7

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL CHAPTER 2.29⁷ "Economic Development Commission" of the City Code of Bloomington.

WHEREAS: the Economic Development Commission of the City of Bloomington has completed a survey of some segments of the community with regard to economic expansion and

WHEREAS: the Economic Development Commission has recommended that it be dissolved and

WHEREAS: the City has the power to proceed to create a statutory development commission according to IC 1971 18-6 and Acts 1973 Public Law 182 (Burns 48-8729-48-8755). An Act to amend IC 1971 18-6 and

WHEREAS: the City of Bloomington seeks urgently to promote economic development for its citizens

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

Section 1: That Chapter 2.79, "Economic Development Commission," of the City Code of Bloomington be repealed.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.
