

ORDINANCE NO. 74-8

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION
OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the Northwest quarter of Section 12,
Township 8 North, Range 2 West, in Monroe
County, Indiana, described as follows, to-wit:
Beginning at a point on the center line of the
Pike Road on or near the quarter section line
through the center of Section 1 and 12 and 563
feet south of the north line of said Section
12, and running thence South on said center
line of said Pike Road, 101 feet, thence West
1287 feet; thence North 101 feet; thence East
1287 feet and to the place of beginning, con-
taining 2.98 acres, more or less.

Said above described real estate is located
at 1824 S. Curry Pike.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries
of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby
declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate
hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington,
Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the
Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.
