## ORDINANCE NO. 74-10

## AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE BLOOMINGTON DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

WHEREAS, it is found that there exists a need for increased commercial and economic development and diversification with corresponding increased employment opportunities in and around the City of Bloomington, and

WHEREAS, it is found that there exists a need to preserve and maintain the quality of the local environment, and

WHEREAS, the State of Indiana has in Indiana Code 18-6-4.5-3 provided for the creation of a department of development and a development commission in Cities to deal with these conditions,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. Chapter 2.79 of the Bloomington Municipal Code entitled "Economic Development Commission" is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. There is hereby added to the Bloomington Municipal Code Chapter 2.79 entitled "Bloomington Development Commission" which is to read as follows:

<u>2.79.010 Creation</u>. There is hereby created within the executive branch of the City of Bloomington a department of development which shall be under the control of a commission to be known as the "Bloomington Development Commission".

2.79.020 Membership. The Bloomington Development Commission shall consist of five (5) members appointed by the Mayor as follows: three (3) of the members so appointed shall be selected by the Mayor; one (1) shall be nominated by the Monroe County Council; and one (1) shall be nominated by the Bloomington Common Council. The Commissioners shall take office upon their appointment and their terms shall run the following number of years from February 1, following such original appointment: two (2) of the commissioners selected by the Mayor--three (3) years, one (1) of the commissioners selected by the Mayor--one (1) year; the commissioner selected by the Common Council-- two (2) years; and the commissioner selected by the County Council--one (1) year.

2.79.030 Powers, Duties, Procedures. The Bloomington Development Commission shall have all the Powers and authorities set for such commissions in I.C. 18-6-4.5-3 and shall bear such duties and responsibilities as are therein set out. The Bloomington Development Commission shall follow such rules and procedures as are now set out in I.C. 18-6-4.5-3, or as shall be added by future amendments to the Indiana Code.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the mayor and publication in accordance with the law.
