

ORDINANCE No. 74-25

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BLOOMINGTON  
MUNICIPAL CODE, TITLE 15, CHAPTER 15.68,  
"Parking Lots."

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington finds it necessary  
to amend the City ordinance governing municipal parking  
lots in order to optimize use of Municipal Parking Lot No. 6,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON  
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION I. That the Bloomington Municipal Code,  
Title 15, Section 15.68.130 (b) is hereby amended to read  
as follows:

(b) There shall be not less than twenty-three parking meters  
erected on Municipal Lot No. 6, and where such parking meters  
have been erected the charge shall be five cents per thirty  
minute period or part thereof and ten cents per sixty minute  
period for the use of each space, and no person shall park a  
vehicle in any such parking meter space for a period of time  
longer than sixty minutes between the hours of eight a.m. and  
five p.m. of any day except Saturdays, Sundays, and public  
holidays. In all other spaces the parking time limit and  
conditions shall be as designated by signs erected and giving  
notice thereof.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force  
and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, and  
publication in accordance with the law.
