

AN ORDINANCE TO CORRECT THE CITY CODE
OF BLOOMINGTON BY ADDING A PENALTY
OMITTED DURING CONDIFICATION

WHEREAS Ordinance 64-33 established a penalty
for an owner of a dog who allows that dog to run at large
or upon the premises of another, and

WHEREAS the 1970 codification of the City Code of
Bloomington omitted this penalty, now therefore

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA:

Section 1. That the following section be added to the
City Code of Bloomington:

4.16.051 Penalty A person who violates § 7.16.050
may be fined up to \$300 or imprisoned up to 10 days or both.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from and after its passage, promulgation and
publication in accordance with the law.


