

ORDINANCE NO. 74- 31

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION
OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the Southwest quarter of Section 32,
Township 9 North, Range 1 West, in Monroe County,
Indiana, bounded and described as follows, to-
wit: Beginning at a point 839.69 feet East of
the Southwest corner of the said Southwest quarter;
thence running North 0 degrees 04 minutes West
for 478 feet and to an old established fence line
forming the South line of the I. C. R. R. real
estate; thence running East over and along the
said old established fence line for 47.43 feet
and to the West right of way of the I. C. R. R.;
thence running in a Southeasterly direction over
and along the said right of way line which is
formed by a curve to the left, and having a
radius of 5780 feet for a distance of 532.8 feet;
thence running West for 288.21 feet and to the
place of beginning, containing in all 1.95 acres,
more or less.

Said above described real estate is located at
1600 West Third Street.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries
of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby
declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate
hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the
Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.
