

ORDINANCE NO. 74-39

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 17.12 OF
THE BLOOMINGTON MUNICIPAL ELECTRICAL
CODE, SECTIONS 17.12.260 and 17.12.270

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON,
INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That Section 17.12 of the Bloomington
Municipal Code be amended by adding thereto the following:

17.12.260 Temporary Service. Temporary electrical
power and lighting installations may be used
during the period of construction, remodeling, or
demolition of buildings, structures, equipment,
or similar activities.

SECTION 2. That Section 17.12 of the Bloomington
Municipal Code be amended by adding thereto the following:

17.12.270 Temporary Permits. Temporary permits
valid for 90 day period will be issued by the
City Engineer for temporary service. At the end
of 90 days, the temporary permit must be renewed if
the work is not completed.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication
in accordance with the law.


