

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 10-05

Passed 9-0

TO SPECIALLY APPROPRIATE FROM THE GENERAL FUND, PARKING ENFORCEMENT FUND, SANITATION FUND, TELECOM FUND, FIRE PENSION FUND, RISK MANGEMENT FUND, AND BOND FUNDS EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED (Appropriating Various Transfers of Funds within the General Fund, Parking Enforcement Fund, Sanitation Fund, and Telecom Fund for Animal Care & Control, Engineering, Police, Housing & Neighborhood Development, Community & Family Resources, City Council, Parking Enforcement, Sanitation, Street, Information & Technology Services; Appropriating Additional Funds from the Fire Pension Fund, Risk Management Fund, and Bond Funds)

- WHEREAS, the Animal Care & Control Department desires to transfer funds from Classification 3 – Services and Charges to Classification 2 – Supplies for animal vaccinations and medicines; and
- WHEREAS, the Engineering Department desires to transfer funds from Classification 3 – Services and Charges to Classification 2 – Supplies to fund MPO traffic counting; and
- WHEREAS, the Police Department desires to transfer funds from Classification 2 – Supplies and Classification 3 – Services and Charges to Classification 4 – Capital Outlays to replace one additional patrol car; and
- WHEREAS, the Housing & Neighborhood Development Department desires to transfer funds from Classification 1 – Salaries & Wages to Classification 2 – Supplies for fuel; and
- WHEREAS, the Community & Family Resources Department desires to transfer funds from Classification 2 – Supplies to Classification 3 – Services and Charges for additional supply needs; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council Office desires to transfer funds from Classification 3 – Services and Charges to Classification 2 – Supplies and Classification 1 – Salaries & Wages for additional payroll needs; and
- WHEREAS, the Parking Enforcement Department desires to transfer funds from Classification 3 – Services and Charges to Classification 1 – Salaries & Wages for additional enforcement officers; and
- WHEREAS, the Parking Enforcement Department desires to transfer funds from Classification 3 – Services and Charges to Classification 4 – Capital Outlays for garage pay station hardware; and
- WHEREAS, the Sanitation Department desires to transfer funds from Classification 3 – Services and Charges to Classification 2 – Supplies for fuel; and
- WHEREAS, the Information & Technology Services Department desires to transfer funds from Classification 3 – Services and Charges to Classification 2 – Supplies for desktop scanners; and
- WHEREAS, the Fire Department desires to increase its budget in the Fire Pension Fund’s Classification 1 – Salaries & Wages to correct an error in the original budget; and
- WHEREAS, the Controller’s Office desires to increase its budget in Classification 3 – Services and Charges in various bond Funds to correct for errors in the original budget; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. For the expenses of said municipal corporation, the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart from the funds herein named and for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same:

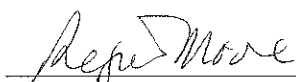

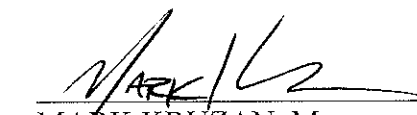

SYNOPSIS

This ordinance appropriates various transfers of funds within the General Fund, Parking Enforcement Fund, Sanitation Fund, and Telecom Fund. It also appropriates additional funds from the Fire Pension Fund, Risk Management Fund, and Bond Funds.

Note this ordinance was revised after it was distributed in the Council Legislative Packet and before it was introduced at the Regular Session on December 1, 2010. The revision corrected a typographical error regarding the transfer of General Fund monies for the Community and Family Resources Department so that it is clear that the money would go from Line 5242 to Line 5399.
