

ORDINANCE NO. 74-53

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION
OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of
Bloomington, Indiana, said land being more specifically described
as follows, to-wit:

Lying in Section 34, Township 9 North,
Range 1 West, Monroe County, Indiana;
Starting at the intersection of the East
right-of-way of State Road 46 and the
South right-of-way of the Illinois Central
Gulf Railroad, running thence North along
the East right-of-way of State Road 46 to
the North right-of-way of 10th Street, thence
West along the North right-of-way of 10th
street to the North right-of-way of Illinois
Central Gulf Railroad, thence West along
the North right-of-way of Illinois Central
Gulf Railroad to the West right-of-way of
Fee Lane, thence South along the West right-
of-way of Fee Lane to the South right-of-way
of Illinois Central Gulf Railroad, thence
East along South right of-way of Illinois
Central Gulf Railroad, to point of beginning.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries
of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby
declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate
hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington,
Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect
from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor
and publication in accordance with the law.
