

ORDINANCE NO. 74- 66

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF
ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

The following described real estate in Monroe County,
State of Indiana, to-wit:

A part of Southwest quarter of Section thirty-
five (35), Township Nine (9) North, Range One
(1) West, Monroe County, Indiana, described as
follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point eleven
and eighty-six hundredths (11.86) chains East ^{750.76}
of the Southwest corner of said Section thirty-
five (35); thence North nineteen and ninety-
eight (19.98) chains to a stone; thence East
twelve (12) chains to a stone; thence South with
the line of the Bollenbacher property nineteen
and ninety-eight hundredths (19.98) chains to
the township line; thence West with said line
twelve and eighteen hundredths (12.18) chains
to the place of beginning, containing twenty-
four (24) acres, more or less, EXCEPTING THERE-
FROM the following to-wit: Beginning in the
Township line, twenty-four and four hundredths
(24.04) chains East of the Southwest corner of
said Southwest quarter; thence North twenty-
three (23) rods; thence West twenty (20) rods
and fourteen (14) feet; thence South twenty-
three (23) rods to the Township line; thence
East to the place of beginning, said exception
containing three (3) acres, more or less, con-
taining after said exception twenty-one (21)
acres, more or less.

The above description describes properties
owned by Ralph Deckard and Ellis Greenhouse, Inc.,
located on East Third Street.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries of
the City of Bloomington, shall be, and the same are, hereby declared
to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove
described as part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect
from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor
and publication in accordance with the law.


