

ORDINANCE NO. 74- 67

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF  
ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,  
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the  
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the city of  
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the Northeast quarter of Section  
three (3), Township eight (8) North, Range  
One (1) West, described as follows, to-wit:  
Beginning at a point that is Four Hundred  
Three and Two Tenths (403.2) feet south of  
the Northwest corner of said quarter section;  
thence running East Two Hundred Twelve and  
Sixty-Two Hundredths (212.62) feet, more or less,  
and to a stone post; thence running South Two  
Hundred Fifty-Six and Eight Tenths (256.8) feet;  
thence running West Two Hundred Twelve and Sixty-  
Two Hundredths (212.62) feet and to the center  
line of South High Street; thence running North  
Two Hundred Fifty-Six and Eight Tenths (256.8)  
feet and to the place of beginning.

The above description describes properties  
owned by Janet Dunn, Fred Seward and Harry  
Rushton located in the 400 Block of South High  
Street.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries of  
the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared  
to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove  
described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect  
from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor  
and publication in accordance with the law.
