

ORDINANCE NO. 74-69

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF
ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of Sections 2, 11, Township 8 North,
Range 1 West, Monroe County, Indiana, more
specifically described as follows:
Beginning at the Southwest corner of Second
Street and College Mall Road, thence South along
the West right-of-way of College Mall to the
Southwest corner of College Mall Road and Moores
Pike, thence East along the South right-of-way
of Moores Pike to the Southwest corner of Moores
Pike and Woodruff Lane, thence due North to the
North right-of-way of Moores Pike, thence West
along the North right-of-way of Moores Pike to
the Northeast corner of Moores Pike and College
Mall Road, thence North along the East right-of-
way of College Mall Road to the Southeast corner
of College Mall Road and Second Street, thence
West to the point of beginning.

The above description describes College Mall Road
South of Second Street and a stretch of Moores
Pike East of College Mall Road.


SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries
of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby
declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate
hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect
from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor
and publication in accordance with the law.

Bloomington, Indiana, on the 3 day of October 1974.


