

ORDINANCE NO. 74-70.

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF
ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of Section 10, Township 8 North, Range 1
West, Monroe County, Indiana, more particularly
described as:
Beginning at a point 600 feet South and 25 feet
West of the Northeast corner of the Northeast
Quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 10,
and on the West right-of-way of South High Street,
thence running West 1641.66 feet to an existing
iron rod at an existing fence corner, thence South
3 degrees 38.3 minutes East along an existing fence
266.54' to a one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) inch iron rod at an exist-
ing fence corner, thence East 1641.66 feet more or
less, and to the West right-of-way of South High
Street, thence North 264 feet, more or less, and
to the point of beginning.


The above description describes properties owned

located on South High Street.


SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries

and publication in accordance with the law.


