

ORDINANCE 74-71

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 2.04 OF THE BLOOMINGTON MUNICIPAL CODE, SECTION 2.04.040, ENTITLED "SERGEANT-AT-ARMS."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That Section 2.04.040, "Sergeant-at-arms" of the Bloomington Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

2.04.040 Sergeant-at-arms.

The Chief of Police shall act as Sergeant-at-arms, or shall order a member of the police department, of the rank of sergeant or higher if available, to act in his/her stead.

It shall be the duty of the Sergeant-at-arms to preserve order in the council chamber under the direction of the presiding officer. In connection with this duty the Sergeant-at-arms can request that any person in attendance at any public meeting of the council surrender any firearm or dangerous weapon in his/her possession for the duration of the meeting or for the time the person is in attendance at the meeting.

The Sergeant-at-arms shall also act as messenger for the Council, under the direction of the City Clerk to serve notices of special meetings upon members and officers of the council and under the direction of the members present at a meeting in which a quorum is not present to procure the attendance of absent members. (Prior code §§ 2-19 (part), 2-22)."

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.
