

ORDINANCE NO. 74 -73

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION
OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:


A part of the Southeast quarter of the South-
east quarter and a part of the Southwest quarter
of the Southeast quarter of Section three (3),
Township Eight (8) North, Range One (1) West
in Monroe County, Indiana, bounded and described
as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the southwest
corner of the southwest quarter of the southeast
quarter of aforesaid section and township, running
thence North 601.00 feet; thence South 88 degrees,
18 minutes East for 296.5 feet; thence North 0 degrees,
08 minutes West for 216.5 feet; thence south 85
degrees 50 minutes East for 1,026.00 feet; thence
South 417.00 feet; thence East 167.00 feet; thence
South 330.00 feet; thence West 1,518.00 feet to
the place of beginning, containing 23.81 acres,
more or less.

The above description describes that area lying
between Windermere Addition and Moore's Pike.


SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries
of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby
declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate
hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect
from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor
and publication in accordance with the law.
